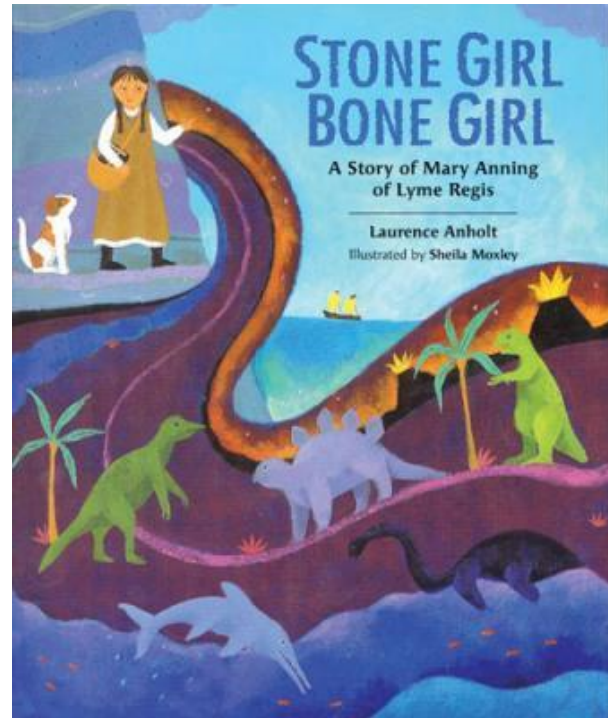

Holdenby House
