How to Grow Sunflowers

Growing sunflowers is easier than you thought. Follow these simple instructions to grow gorgeous sunflowers for your garden.

You will need:

Pots

Multipurpose compost

Sunflower seeds

Watering can



Method:

- 1. Fill each pot with the compost leaving a small gap at the top.
- 2. Insert a sunflower seed into the soil pointy edge down by giving it a gentle push.
- 3. Sprinkle some soil over the top carefully.
- 4. Give each pot a good watering using a watering can.
- 5. Place the pots on a warm, sunny windowsill.
- 6. Continue to water the plants daily.
- 7. Once they have started to grow and the risk of frost has passed, you can plant them outside.

Hopefully, you will now be able to enjoy your beautiful sunflowers as they brighten up your garden.
