Write to persuade: Leaflet

Purpose: To persuade the reader to buy something

Key features



Structural:

- -Introduction to tell the reader what the leaflet is about
- -Pictures and photos of the place
- -Paragraphs with subheadings
- -Conclusion to tell you how to book

Language:

- -Rhetorical questions: Have you ever wanted to visit Rome?
- -Positive language to describe the place: fresh ingredients and elegant simplicity
- -Modal verbs to suggest things to the reader: there are many activities you can enjoy.
