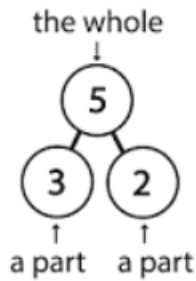
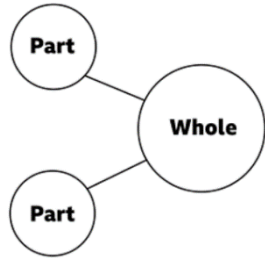

Addition and Subtraction

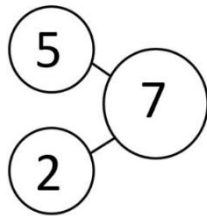
When we add objects, we group them together then count them to see how many there are altogether. Subtracting means we take objects away from the group, then we count to see how many we have left.

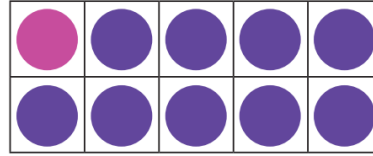

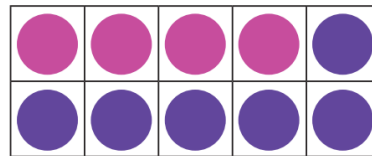


Number Bonds



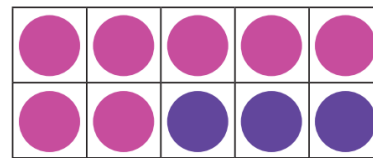
$$1 + 9 = 10$$

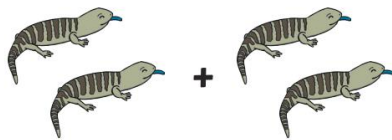

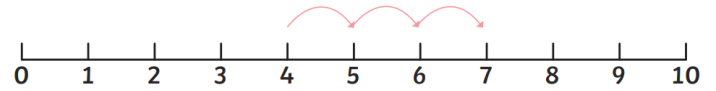
