Year 3

In Year 3, we begin to combine larger amounts of pounds and pence. It is important to be able to convert pounds and pence so that we can combine different values of coins when using money to pay for items. We will also use our skills of addition and subtraction to add and subtract amounts of money.

Builds from Year 2:

Recognise £ and p.

Select coins to make a specific value.

Equal amounts.

Finding totals.

Giving change.

This year:

Convert pounds and pence. Add and subtract money. Giving change.

Leads to Year 4:

Money

£52 and 13 pence

Converting Pounds & Pence











120 pence 100 pence is £1 120 pence is £1 and 20 pence

Adding Amounts



£1 and 60p + £1 and 52p. There is £2 and 112p.

112p is £1 and 12p.

Altogether there is £3 and 12p.




Subtracting Amounts

£2 and 35p - £1 and 80p



Giving Change



£9 - £5 = £4

100p - 67p = 33p

£4 and 33p change
