Dear Parents and Carers

Winter illness has hit the school hard this week, with both staff and children being cut down with a vicious virus. As a school, we have tried to cover staff absence internally with staff known to the children and we hope you have seen little disruption. We wish all the children and staff who are unwell at the moment a speedy recovery. Don't forget, there are simple things we can all do to help prevent the spread of infections:

- cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when coughing and sneezing, dispose of used tissue in a waste bin, and wash hands
- cough or sneeze into the inner elbow (upper sleeve) if no tissues are available, rather than into the
- keep contaminated hands away from their eyes, mouth and nose
- clean hands after contact with respiratory secretions and contaminated objects and materials

This week saw our annual **CHRISTINGLE** assembly take place, led by Revd Mike Morris from the Watling Valley Partnership. Whatever your religion, Christingle is a joyful celebration that brings families and communities together to share kindness and spread the message of hope. Year 5 children, as part of their RE curriculum, got to make and take a Christingle home after sharing some of their wishes for the world with KS2. We then were able to light the candles and sing a Christmas carol together. This time of reflection can be really powerful.

The theme of kindness was also seen in my assembly this week, where I shared with the children details of the **WHITE RIBBON CHARITY**. Firstly, may I say a huge thank you to the parents/carers who took the time to email or speak to me about how happy they were that we were supporting this cause and raising awareness. With the children, I spoke about how the charity encourages everyone to make a promise to never hurt someone or keep quiet when someone make us feel sad or afraid. The key take away is that **"kindness starts with me"**. We discussed what kindness looks like but also what kindness feels like, how we need to embrace our differences and treat everyone with kindness, use words and actions that are helpful and kind and to speak to an adult if they need support. I also asked them to remember these when they are....at home...in class...on the playground...or doing their favourite hobby.

As per last week's newsletter, this year **WILLEN HOSPICE** are running a **XMAS CARD COMPETITION**. They are proud to serve their community as the only hospice in Milton Keynes that provides free, compassionate care to those who need it. A large number of our families have been supported by them. They have now delivered entry form cards and entrants can design any Christmas themed drawing in the allocated space on the card; these can be collected from the school reception. Please also return completed forms there. Once the entry form has been completed, there will be a Sum-Up QR on the entry card which takes you to a suggested £1 donation link, but we also have a Willen Hospice **DONATION BUCKET** in Reception if you prefer this method. Thank you for supporting this great cause!

As you are aware, we have **FLU VACCINATIONS** taking place in school on 12th December. On top of this, the **NHS** has organised **IMMUNISATION CATCH-UP** walk-in clinics to help children catch up on routine vaccinations. The clinics offer vaccinations for diseases such as measles, mumps, rubella, and other preventable illnesses. They are open to all eligible children without the need for prior booking - parents and carers can simply walk in at their convenience. The next clinic for school aged children will be held this coming **Saturday 7 December from 10am till 2pm at Marsh Drive Community Centre, Marsh Drive, Great Linford, Milton Keynes, MK14 5HH.**

As a school we will be celebrating **NATIONAL CHRISTMAS JUMPER DAY** on Thursday 12th December. There is no donation needed at all, it's just a little part of our celebrations around this time of the year. This is of course not compulsory and normal school uniform needs to be worn with the jumpers please.

Our **OPAL** lunchtime journey goes from strength to strength with **FREEDOM FRIDAY 5** taking place today! The children appear to really enjoy the change and we are adding new activities week on week. Next week, (following our play assembly on Monday), we will be introduce **DEN BUILDING** and **LOOSE PARTS** play. 

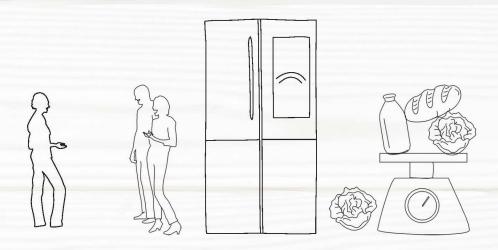
