



Home Learning

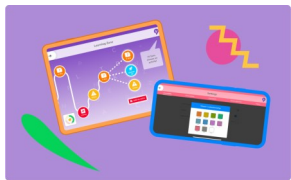

DoodleEnglish, DoodleTables*

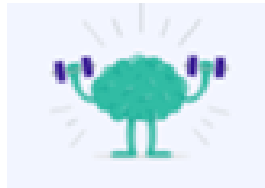
