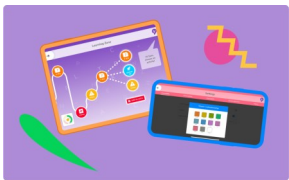

Choose 10 words that you do not know how to spell and practice them. When you have learnt them choose some new words.

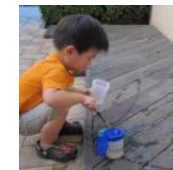


Well-being:
