Advice for Dealing with Nudes – Think Before You Share

School aged males and females are engaged in sharing intimate materials. This is a by-product of the internet age.

The personal nature and potentially embarrassing subject matter can make it hard to know what to say. This can be particularly tricky since this behaviour can be transmitted through social media programmes and personal messaging acts. This can lead to bullying, inter-personal issues and general harms.

The role of surrender in creating space for growth.

"We must be willing to let go of the life we have planned, so as to have the life that is waiting for us."— E.M. Forster

We all want to overcome our internal resistance so we can keep moving forward and making progress. However, how we do this requires deep, unconscious surrender so we can accept what our current reality as it is — especially the things beyond our control.

This acceptance is not submission or defeat; it's a powerful shift that creates space for healing, growth, and new possibilities. And while letting go in this way can be challenging, it's essential for unlocking deeper therapeutic breakthroughs.

The takeaway: When you see signs of self resistance, encourage yourself to view surrender not as giving up or losing control... but as a way to engage more fully with life, take positive action, and initiate authentic growth regardless of your circumstances.

"What possibilities or opportunities might become available if I stopped struggling against my current reality?". By imaging new outcomes, you can reframe your situation, moving from a mindset of struggle and limitation to one of curiosity and possibility.

*These 14 days don't need to be in a row. A day of use is defined as completing at least one exercise between 00:01 and 23:59.


How to create and/or link a parent account to your child's school account

Creating a parent account is really important (and really easy!). By doing this, you'll be able to enter the Summer Challenge and claim your child's personalised certificate by visiting <u>parents.doodlelearning.com</u>, our online parent hub.

How to create and/or link a parent account via the Doodle apps

- Log in to any of the Doodle apps using the username and password provided by your child's school. If you're not sure what these are, please contact your child's school rather than creating a new account for them.
- 2 From the Learning Zone, click on the arrow icon in the top left-hand corner of the screen
- 3 Select Settings and press Parent details
- 4 If you're new to Doodle, choose Create parent account. If you already have a Doodle account, click on Link existing account.
- 5 Enter your details to link your email address to your child's account









How to create and/or link a parent account via the Parent Dashboard

- 1 Visit parents.doodlelearning.com
- 2 If you're new to Doodle, click on Create account and follow the instructions. After you've done this, log in to <u>parents.doodlelearning.com</u>. If you already have a parent account, log in to <u>parents.doodlelearning.com</u>.
- 3 Once you've logged in, hover over My account and select Child details
- 4 Click on Link to my child's school account and enter the username and password provided by your child's school. If you're not sure what these are, please contact your child's school rather than creating a new account for them.
