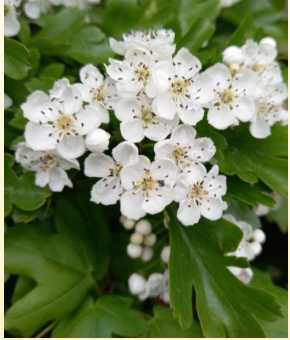



Outdoor Learning:


Using chalk or water and a paint brush, practise your spellings outside ;
